

Bolder Innovations Privacy Policy

This privacy policy (statement) covers the website that is operated by Bolder Innovations, Inc. That site is www.bolderinnovations.com. Our privacy policy includes:

1. What personally identifiable information third parties collect through the Bolder Innovations website.
2. What organization collects the information.
3. How Bolder Innovations uses the information.
4. With whom Bolder Innovations may share user information.

Personally Identifiable Information Third Parties collect through Bolder Innovations website

Information Collection

1. Bolder Innovations collects information from users through our site when a user actively responds to our site by sending us an email. We collect the email address, the name of user as the user gives it to us through the email and the content of the email.
2. A cookie is a piece of data stored on the user's computer tied to information about the user. Usage of a cookie is in no way linked to any personally identifiable information while on our site. We may use both session ID cookies and persistent cookies. For the session ID cookie, once users close the browser, the cookie simply terminates. A persistent cookie is a small text file stored on the user's hard drive for an extended period of time. Persistent cookies can be removed by following Internet browser help file directions.
3. Like most standard Web site servers we use log files. This includes internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, internet service provider (ISP), referring/exit pages, platform type, date/time stamp, and number of clicks to analyze trends, administer the site, track user's movement in the aggregate, and gather broad demographic information for aggregate use. IP addresses, etc. are not linked to personally identifiable information. We use the VodaHost tracking utility that uses log files to analyze user movement.

Sharing Information

1. Though we make every effort to preserve user privacy, we may need to disclose personal information when required by law wherein we have a good-

faith belief that such action is necessary to comply with a current judicial proceeding, a court order or legal process served on our Web site.

2. We may from time to time partner with other third parties to provide specific services. We may share names, or other contact information that is necessary for the third party to provide these services. These third parties are not allowed to use personally identifiable information except for the purpose of providing these services.
3. We may share aggregated, non-personally identifiable information publicly and with our partners – like publishers, advertisers, banks, financial institutions or connected sites. For example, we may share information publicly to show trends about the general use of our services.
4. Our Privacy Policy does not apply to services offered by other companies or individuals, including other sites linked from our website or services. Our Privacy Policy does not cover the information practices of other companies and organizations who advertise on our website or use our website.
